A renovated trip destination at the outskirts of Prague – the Mýto nature trail

Nedvězí near Prague (27 September 2012) –The Czech Union for Nature Conservation (CSOP) together with its general partner, NET4GAS, presented another nature location to the public. The Mýto nature trail will show visitors around the romantic valley of the Rokytka brook and familiarise them with the reasons for the protection of this hidden piece of nature at the outskirts of Prague.

The nature trail runs through one of the most beautiful parts of the south-eastern outskirts of our capital. Though the area of the Mýto nature reserve is less than 18 hectares, natural grove vegetation full of spring flowers, valley meadows, age-old willow trees and abandoned slate quarries can be found here. The sinuous watercourse of the Rokytka brook creates spectacular meanders in the locality. The banks eroded by the high water suit to the “jewel of our nature”, rare Kingfisher. One would not believe that he is still in Prague...

Neither tourist nor cycle routes run through Mýto, and the nature trail existing here in the eighties of the 20th century ceased to exist long time ago. Only extraordinarily observant and eagle-eyed visitors were able to find the route in the wild valley. However, the “Botič-Rokytka” Basic Organisation of the Czech Union for Nature Conservation that takes care of many interesting nature places of this area, as its name suggests after all, did not forget about the natural riches of the Mýto locality. “It was our longtime member and expert on this valley, the botanist Vítězslav Jaroš who came up with the idea of the renovation of the onetime nature trail,” says RNDr. Jitka Loubová, Chairwoman of the Botič-Rokytka Organisation of the Czech Union for Nature Conservation. “When the opportunity for funding a natural trail presented itself within the NET4GAS’s Closer to Nature programme, not for a moment did we hesitate about where to direct our efforts. Mýto definitely deserves greater interest of the public.”

Besides six stopovers of the nature trail, a new footbridge over the brook was built in collaboration with the Prague –Nedvězí District City Hall and the part of the way, closed until then, was opened to allow passage on the left bank of Rokytka. This project maximally fulfils the vision of the NET4GAS’s Closer to Nature programme. People will comfortably and safely get to the local unique nature and realise the reasons for the need of its protection,” said Milan Řepka, spokesperson for NET4GAS.

The route is almost circular and is 2.5 km long. The right-bank part of the route is accessible even for visitors with bikes or for parents with baby carriages; the second part runs through a more difficult terrain on a narrow path and is intended exclusively for walking. The circle is well marked with a green band in a white square. Transport connection: by bus No. 267 from the underground C line Háje terminal station to the Hájová station at Nedvězí. Hikers can see the nature trail information panel right there.
